HOW TO:

RESPOND TO YOUR TENANT(S)' DEPOSIT **ALLOCATION** PROPOSAL VIA THE **NEW TDS PORTAL**







STEP BY STEP

IF A TENANT HAS RAISES A DEPOSIT ALLOCATION PROPOSAL


If a tenant has raised a deposit allocation proposal, TDS Insured will ask you to access the relevant deposit through your account so that you can respond to the proposal.

On your 'Deposit summary' page there will be two tabs at the top of the page – **Deposit Summary** and **My Account.**

When you select **Next Step** from the previous page, you'll automatically land on the 'Deposit summary' tab.


Select **Review Proposal** to review the tenant's application.

Here, you will be shown information relating to the tenancy.






To return to your deposit management account,, select Back to deposit management.



Once you select **Review proposal** from the 'Deposit summary' page, you will be taken through to the deposit allocation journey.






If you don't intend to make any deductions to the tenant(s)' deposit, please press No.

If you select **No**, we will warn you that we will advise the tenant(s) that you are not making any deductions to the deposit and that the repayment will be made by you, or the deposit holder, **within 5 working days.**

If you click **Submit**, we will confirm your submission, and we'll reach out to the tenant(s) to inform them that you will not be making any deductions to the deposit. We will also inform the tenant(s) that they should expect repayment of the deposit amount **within 5** working days.






If you do not wish to make any deductions to the tenant(s)' deposit, please select No.


If you select **No** to this question, you'll be notified that we will advise the tenant(s) that you do not wish to make deductions from the deposit and that the repayment will be made by you, or the deposit holder, within **5 working days.**

Once you have read this message, you will need to confirm that there are no deductions being made from the deposit by clicking **Submit**.





Once you have confirmed that you do not wish to make deductions to the tenant(s)' deposit, you will **receive a confirmation message** to confirm that TDS Insured have received your submission.



Our team will contact the tenant(s) and will advise them that you **do not wish to make deductions from the deposit.**

We will also advise the tenant(s) to **expect the repayment** from you, or the deposit holder, within **5 working days.**


You should also contact the tenant(s) to let them know that the deposit amount will be released to them within **5 working days.**





If you do wish to make deductions to the tenant(s)' deposit, please select Yes.

You will be asked to confirm how much money has already been paid to the tenant(s). Any part of the deposit amount that has already been returned to the tenant(s) will not be considered if the case proceeds to adjudication.








If the deductions being claimed **exceed the total** deposit amount protected by TDS Insured, you will have the opportunity to **add further details** if the case proceeds to **adjudication**.

If you are planning on making any deductions to the tenant(s) deposit, you will be asked at this stage to **specify the categories** that your deductions fall under.


You will **NOT** be asked to provide any evidence for the deductions at this stage. TDS Insured will ask you to provide evidence for the deductions **if the case proceeds to adjudication.**






If you are claiming any amount under other, you will be asked to provide a brief explanation of the claim for '**Other**'.

This field is mandatory to complete.





Once you have completed your initial proposal, select **Continue** to review your proposal.






Your proposal summary will feature:

- 1 The tenancy end date as entered by you
- 2 Any amount that you have already returned or will be returning to the tenant(s) as it is not being claimed
- 3 Any deductions that you wish to make to the tenant(s)' deposit

If you're happy with your proposal, select Submit to send your proposal to TDS.





A message will appear to tell you that you have **successfully submitted your deposit allocation** proposal to TDS.

If you'd like to review the proposal that you have submitted, select the **Go to deposit** summary button to head back to the deposit summary page.
